- 2. Example: hkws Brad Pitt
- Follow the registration link you are sent from GalaBid to login and place bids.

Please note: capitals are not needed

To Register via browser:

Visit: galabid.com/hkws

- 1. Click on the 'register' button
- 2. Enter your details and click 'submit'.
- 3. You will then receive a text to your mobile phone with the link to the auction catalogue and a passcode. Use the passcode to login on any browser or click the link in the text to be automatically logged in on the

browser on your smart phone. You are now ready to bid.

Don't have a Smart phone?

- 1. Register as above, then you will be able to place bids via SMS or via your browser
- 2. Text bids to the same number 61458678678
- 3. Enter the amount in without any symbols followed by the letter 'L' and the Item number with no spaces between.

Example: to bid \$ 99 on item 33,

Text: 99L33
